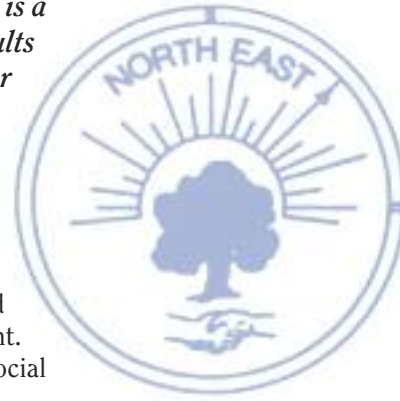

Established in the early 1970s, North East Westchester Special Recreation is a community-based therapeutic recreation agency serving children and adults with developmental disabilities in the north east portion of Westchester County. North East is the second largest agency of its kind in the State of New York and has gained local and state-wide attention for the quality and novelty of programs and services.



Programs

North East programs offer a variety of year-round recreational activities designed with the specific support needed for participant success in this environment. Programs may focus on teaching skills, developing friendships, correcting social or behavioral deficiencies and having fun.

Program options include: Special Olympics training and competition in a variety of sports, art and music therapy, community trips, vacation programs, summer day camp, dances, theme parties, therapeutic swim, leisure activities, social skills training and much more.

Our participants range in age from four years to senior citizens. Program placement is based on the participant's interests, their age and ability. North East programs are held in community facilities such as schools, municipal buildings and recreation centers.
